

# How to place bets at Elitloppet

## Background

Since January 1st 2019, registration and identification is mandatory in Sweden for anyone placing bets on any of ATG's games. This is in order to comply with the statutory requirements.

Foreign visitors at a Swedish racetrack who wants to place a bet, will need to register at the racetrack using their passport. When registration is completed you will receive an ID-receipt. ID-receipt and passport must always be showed at the betting counter when making a bet, collecting a win or cancelling a bet.

## Pre-registration

To save time you can pre-register your personal information online at <http://www.swedishhorseracing.com/fasttrack> and receive a personal QR-code for a quicker and smoother registration at the racetrack. Bring your personal QR-code, on paper or in your mobile, along with your passport, to the racetrack. Present your QR-code and passport at the registration area or at a betting counter to receive your personal ID-receipt.

## On track-registration

Registration when arriving to the racetrack is also an option and follows the same formula as online, but will take a bit longer. Once registration is completed you will receive your personal ID-receipt.

The personal ID-receipt will be valid throughout Elitloppet and the following race days in Lindsberg and Eskilstuna 28-27<sup>th</sup> May.

## Betting on the racetrack

When making a bet, collecting a win or cancelling a bet at a counter you will always have to show your passport and personal ID-receipt.

You can pay with all major Visa- and Mastercards as well as cash up to 10 000 SEK.

## Remember

- Passport for registration.
- Passport + ID-receipt for betting.
- Register early, before or as soon as you get to the racetrack.
